DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- What insight, principle, or observation from Sunday did you find to be the most helpful, eye-opening, or troubling? Explain.
- In what ways do you compare yourself with others?
- Do you feel you are living your life in the middle? Explain
- From the list in Colossians 3:5, which of these have to die in order for you to live? Explain.
- Are there bitter feelings towards some people that you need to put to death in order to live in peace with everyone? (Col. 3:8,9) Explain.
- Do you need to die to selfishness at home and live by serving those that mean the most to you? (Col. 3:18-21) Explain.
- Do you need to die to self at work and live by being an earthly representative of Christ, or are you going to continue to give Christ a bad reputation? (Col. 3:22, 4:1) Explain.
- Why do we settle for middle ground in our spiritual lives while striving for the best at work, in relationships, in sports, or other areas?

DIGGING DEEPER (Questions taken from Serendipity Bible for Groups)

Read Luke 9:18-27

- What does it mean specifically for you to: (a) deny yourself, (b) take up your cross daily, (c) follow Christ, and (d) lose your life?
- Knowing what you do know, would you reconsider your commitment to Christ? Why or why not?

APPLICATION

- Choose one aspect in your pursuit of living a Christ Centered life that you know you can do better. What is your first step in getting out of the middle? How can your Life Group help?
